I am directed to enclose a copy of the reference cited received from the Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, New Delhi enhancing the rate of Dearness Allowance from 9% to 12% of pay to the Central Government Employees with effect from 01.01.2019 and direct that the All India Service Officers serving in the State will be allowed Dearness Allowance at the increased rate of 12% with effect from 01.01.2019. They are authorized to draw the payment of enhanced Dearness Allowance at 12% with effect from 01.01.2019 and to draw in cash with effect from 01.01.2019. The payment of arrears of Dearness allowance shall not be made before the date of disbursement of salary of March 2019.

## OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Grant of Dearness Allowance to Central Government employees - Revise Rates effective from 1.1.2019.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's Office Memorandum Not 1/2/2018-E-II (B) dated 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 on the subject mentioned above and to sa that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Allowance payable to Centra Government employees shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 9% to 12% of the bas pay with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2019.

- 2. The term 'basic pay' in the revised pay structure means the pay drawn in the prescribed Level in the Pay Matrix as per 7<sup>th</sup> CPC recommendations accepted by the Government, but does not include any other type of pay like special pay, etc.
- 3. The Dearness Allowance will continue to be a distinct element of remuneration ar will not be treated as pay within the ambit of FR 9(21).
- 4. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fractions of 50 paise ar above may be rounded to the next higher rupee and the fractions of less than 50 paise may be ignored.
- 5. The payment of arrears of Dearness Allowance (from January to March) shall r be made before the date of disbursement of salary of March, 2019.
- 6. These orders shall also apply to the civilian employees paid from the Defen Services Estimates and the expenditure will be chargeable to the relevant head of t Defence Services Estimates. In respect of Armed Forces personnel and Railw employees, separate orders will be issued by the Ministry of Defence and Ministry Railways, respectively.
- 7. In so far as the employees working in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders are issued with the concurrence of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
